- All Breed Classes (for horses and equines of any breed including mules, donkeys, drafts, ponies and minis)
 - All breed classes qualify for year end awards in NM Paint Horse Club and the NM Palomino Exhibitors Association.
 - All breed classes also count towards the 2024 All Breed Year End Awards Program co-sponsored by the NM Paint, Pinto, Palomino and Appaloosa Clubs.
 - AND All Breed classes are also eligible for credits or points in the following national breed association programs:
 - PAC (Paint Alternative Competition)
 - SOAR (Pinto Select Opportunities & Rewards)
 - OCAP (Pinto Open Competition Activities Program)
 - P3 eligible (Palomino Performance Program)
 - ACAAP (Appaloosa Competitive All-Breed Activities Program)
 - And more.....

GENERAL SHOW RULES:

- Classes will be governed by appropriate breed association and/or state and local club rules.
- Show management reserves the right to combine and/or cancel classes based on APHA, PtHA and/or PHBA rules.
- Youth classes will be held with one entry or combined or cancelled as allowed by breed rules.
- Open and Amateur classes with one entry may be canceled or combined where allowed.
- Stall Reservation Form must be completed for every horse (equine) on grounds.
- Questions concerning rules and fees as published may be presented to Show Management for clarification. In the event of typographical or other errors in class list, fee schedule, forms and show info; the corrected spelling or intended meaning shall be substituted. Show Management decisions will be final.

Stalls and indoor arena at Wright's will NOT be available for move-in or schooling prior to 5 pm on Friday, October 26th, without prior arrangements with stall manager.

- ***PLEASE NOTE THIS IS NOT A TRAINING SHOW AND TRAINING DEVICES ARE NOT ALLOWED IN ANY CLASS.***
- There are no speakers in the barn areas or the parking lots at Wright's. Please stay alert and listen to announcements made in the horse arena regarding class times and class calls.
- Please be aware that email, texting and internet access at Wright's (especially inside the indoor arena and barn) may NOT be instantaneous communication.
- While show management will do its best to keep all exhibitors informed, it is ultimately the exhibitors' responsibility to be ready at the gate when their class is called.
- Show management reserves the right to change arenas and schedule due to weather and/or other circumstances.
- To keep the show running smoothly, please notify gate person of any tack changes and have your tack ready at the gate.
- **There will be a two minute gate for all classes. No exceptions.**
- Exhibitors requiring special accommodations should consult their breed association rulebooks for procedures regarding applying for variances. If not covered by breed rules, APHA rules will prevail.

ENTRIES:

ENTRIES MUST BE MADE ON PROPERLY COMPLETED AND SIGNED ENTRY FORM(S) and A PROPERLY COMPLETED AND SIGNED RELEASE & WAIVER MUST ACCOMPANY ENTRIES (found with entry forms).

Please complete one entry form per horse per breed. There is a separate page for each breed – Paint, Pinto, Palomino and All Breed entries.

Please note that Pinto entries MUST be made on an official Pinto entry form! The Pinto Master Entry Form is sent to PtHA to record show results. ONLY Pinto entries may be made on the Pinto entry form. In classes designated by Type (Stock & Hunter or Pleasure Type), horse MUST be shown in type indicated on PtHA Registration Papers. In Pinto classes with no designated type, all Pinto horses may show.

PRE ENTRIES are highly recommended but not required. A discounted Office fee of \$25.00 is available for exhibitors submitting completed entry forms along with all required copies of registration papers for horse and membership cards for owner(s) and exhibitor(s) for APHA, PtHA and PHBA horses AND entering at least one class by October 18th. Pre-payment not required. Please see checklist at bottom of Release & Waiver form for list of required documentation needed for making entries.

- PLEASE send ALL pre-entries to the APHA show secretary for entry into the show computer software: Berniece Zielke, email viabz@aol.com or mail to PO Box 908, Belen, NM. Pre- entries must be RECEIVED by October 18th and must include all required paperwork (including copies of registration papers and membership cards for breed association entries) to receive discounted office fee. Please allow transit time for mailed entries to be received by the deadline. Entries will be accepted at show in the show office. Classes can be added in the show office or at the gate provided the horse is already entered in the show.
- Back numbers will be assigned by the show secretary. A specific back number may be requested on your entry form(s). We will do our best to accommodate your request. If you are requesting a specific number, you will

need to provide your own physical back numbers. It is the exhibitor's responsibility to wear number assigned by show secretary or risk disqualification.

- Pre-entry will speed up check in and entry process on day of show and save you money.
- Office fee if entering or providing required paperwork after October 18th is \$35.00
- Pre-payment of entry fees or stalls is not required. Cattle reservations require pre-payment.
- Please note that any mailed entries must be received by show secretary on or before October 23rd.
- **Adding and scratching classes for horses already entered in show.**
 - Adding or scratching classes for horses already entered in show can be done in office (preferably) or at the gate before a class begins and must be on properly completed and signed add/scratch forms.
 - If adding any classes at the gate, please review your bill before closing out your tab to verify the class(es) appear on your bill. There is sometimes a delay between the class being run and placed and the office getting a final tally for the class. Exhibitors will be billed for all classes entered.
 - **Scratches** – If made on a scratch form prior to a class, entry fee for that class will not be charged.
 - If for any reason you do not scratch a class and are considered a **"NO SHOW"** causing a delay in the show, you will be charged your office fee and for the classes entered. Please contact the Show Contact, Show Secretary or Show Manager listed on page 1 by phone, text or email if you have pre-entered and cannot make it to the show for any reason.
- By bringing horses (equines) to this event, I (we) the owner(s)/exhibitor(s)/responsible party(ies) agree to abide by the by- laws, standing rules, judging, & show rules (including but not limited to sportsmanship & responsible conduct) of the NMPHC, APHA (American Paint Horse Assoc.), PtHANM, PtHA (Pinto Horse Association of America), NMPEA and PHBA (Palomino Horse Breeders of America). The owners/exhibitors/responsible parties release NMPHC, APHA, PtHANM, PtHA, NMPEA, PHBA & their respective members, staff and volunteers, Wright's Rockin' Horse Arena & their owner/operators from any loss to myself, dependents, employees, agents, horses, &/or equipment while attending &/or participating in this show. They must also acknowledge & accept responsibility for any damage to stalls/tack rooms & facility which results in charges to show management. Owners/exhibitors/responsible parties must also acknowledge that they have read & understand show rules as outlined in breed rule books, the "Fall Color Roundup Horse Show Information" and in this waiver of liability. The provisions contained herein are hereby made a part of any agreement to participate at this event.

ENTRY FEES:

- Paint, Pinto and All Breed Classes will be double judged. Entry fees are for both judges, i.e. fees do NOT get doubled for two judges.
- Palomino Classes will be single judged. PHBA entry fees listed are for one judge, i.e. fees do NOT get split for one judge.
- Championship classes will be single judged and there is no entry fee. Must qualify to participate in class by placing 1st or 2nd in qualifying classes. Championship awards count both judges' scores. See Championship Rules.
- Fun classes will be single judged and half of the entry fee will be jackpotted (see Fun Class Rules).
- See entry fee schedule or bill worksheet for all fees including any All Show Fees and/or Special All Inclusive Fees.
- Payment of all fees (either by cash, money order or with signed check payable to NMPHC) is required prior to picking up exhibitor number(s) at show office. Due to the multiple special and multiple breed fees, billing statements cannot be generated until all horse, owner and exhibitor(s) information and all fees (including stalls, breed fees, equipment fees, etc.) and class entries are input into the show software program. Pre-entries are encouraged. Final bills will not be hand calculated and will be audited for accuracy within 30 days after the show. Corrected bills or refunds will be issued after bills are audited. An optional bill worksheet is available to help you calculate your total bill. You can send the worksheet with your entries but it is not required.
- There will be a \$50.00 charge to owner/exhibitor for any checks returned by a banking institution for any reason.
- **Important!!! ENTRIES IN MULTIPLE DIVISIONS WILL NOT BE COMBINED FOR ALL SHOW FEES except as listed in on Show Fee Schedule. Please ask if you have questions!**

- FYI – A Pinto Horse Association (PtHA) Field Representative will be onsite at the show to register Pintos and Pinto Solids.
- An NM Palomino Exhibitor Assoc. Board Member will be available to assist with Palomino Horse Breeders of America (PHBA) registrations.
- GREAT IDEA IF YOU WANT TO GET PINTO, PINTO SOLID, PALOMINO OR PALOMINO BRED PAPERS ON YOUR HORSE!
 - Pinto recognizes over 70 outcross breeds and more for horses meeting color requirements.
 - Pinto accepts numerous outcross breeds in the Solid Registry including Quarter Horses, Paints, Appaloosas, Arabians and horses with undocumented registry.
 - Palomino registers Palomino horses registered in numerous breeds and undocumented Palominos provided they meet conformation and color requirements.
 - Palomino Bred registration is for horses with at least one registered Palomino registered parent or Palomino horses with excessive white such as regular registry Paints and Pintos.

- GET IT DONE PRIOR TO THE SHOW! PLEASE call and make arrangements prior to show date.

CONCURRENT CLASSES:

Class numbers boxed together on the class list will be run concurrently. Show management reserves the right to run classes concurrently when possible at this show. When classes are run concurrently, you are NOT required to enter all of the classes which will run concurrently. You may enter only the class(es) you choose and will only earn points (towards show awards, state points and national points) in the class(es) you entered and paid an entry fee. Cattle Fees charged per Go, i.e. enter a Paint and Pinto concurrent class, pay entry fee for each breed or all breed class and pay ONE cattle fee. National, state and/or show points will be reported and calculated using the number of horses entered in your class, not using the total number of horses in the concurrent class. **Please ask if you have questions. You CANNOT post enter a class.**

CROSS ENTERING CLASSES:

- **Breed Association Walk/Trot Classes –**
 - Exhibitors showing in breed association approved walk/trot classes may NOT show in breed association walk/trot classes **and** walk/trot/lope (canter) classes at the same event.
 - If showing in a breed association walk/trot class, exhibitor **CANNOT show in a breed association and/or All Breed walk/trot/lope (canter) classes** at this show but can show in Ranch Conformation, Halter, Color, Longe Line, In Hand Trail and Showmanship. HORSE may be shown by another exhibitor in walk/trot/lope (canter) classes.
- The **All Breed Walk/Trot Classes** are open to all exhibitors (except leadline exhibitors) but the Walk/Trot High Point Awards are limited to exhibitors (or horses in open green w/t) showing only in walk/trot classes.
- **Lead Line Classes**
 - Youth may NOT cross enter leadline and any mounted walk/trot or walk/trot/lope (canter) classes.
 - For Breed Association Leadline Classes, breed rules will be used.
 - **Paint Lead Line** (ages 3 – 8) – Exhibitor need not own horse. Open to all registered Paints (Regular Registry and Solid Paint Bred).
 - **Pinto Lead Line** (eight & under) – Exhibitor need not own or lease horse. Open to Pintos with color or Solid Registry horse, pony or mini or Long Ear registry.
 - **Be sure to check your breed association rules for Lead Line classes.**
 - For the All Breed Leadline Class, assistance by side walkers or spotters is allowed.

- **Ranch Class Rules** - Please consult your 2024 breed association rulebook for ranch class rules and the restrictions (if any) on cross entering other classes such as Ranch Rail Pleasure and Western Pleasure. Not all the breeds have the same rules concerning cross-entries. It is the exhibitors' responsibility to know the rules and enter the correct classes.
- **Fall Color Roundup All Breed** exhibitors may cross enter All Breed ranch and All Breed traditional show classes.
- APHA, NMPHC, PtHA, PtHANM, PHBA and NMPEA rules to prevail.

STALL RESERVATIONS & PARKING:

- Stall reservation forms required for a guaranteed stall.
- ALL horses (equines) must complete a stall reservation form whether stalling at show grounds or working out of trailer (tie out), whether showing or not. There is no charge for working out of trailer (tie-out) but a form must be completed. If a stall form is not completed, a stall fee will be charged for each day on the show grounds.
- Please send all stall reservation and RV/LQ reservation forms to Ron Morris, PO Box 908, Belen, NM 87002. Please do not send with your entries. Mailed forms must be received by Wednesday, October 23rd.
- Stalls and indoor arena at Wright's will NOT be available for move in or schooling prior to 5 pm on Friday, October 25th, without prior approval of show management.
- Shavings are available onsite. Outside shavings are not allowed at this facility due to their recycling program.
- There are 20 acres of available parking. Please do not park closer than 12 feet from the trailer nearest yours. If you are working out of your trailer, please distance even more than that. Show staff will be on the grounds to enforce this.
- RV/LQ Power (some with Water) Hookups require a reservation as there are a limited number of hookups available.
- If you have not been assigned trailer parking, please back your trailer in perpendicular to fence west of arena or south of stalls.

CATTLE RESERVATIONS:

\$50 per head/per go in Ranch Cow Work, Box/Drive and Boxing classes. \$65 per class/per horse in Cutting classes. Cattle reservations with pre-payment are due October 18th. Show management reserves right to cancel cattle classes if insufficient cattle have been reserved. Cattle fees will be refunded if classes are canceled by show management.

Otherwise, cattle fees are NON-REFUNDABLE after the reservation due date. Ultimate decision on any refunds will be made by show management. Late entries may be accepted but exhibitor may have to use re-work cattle.

FOR ALL CUTTING CLASSES: Exhibitors are responsible for providing their own turn back and herd holders. Failure to do so will result in contestant not being allowed to show and no refunds will be given. Two minute gate call will be strictly enforced.

HALTER & RANCH CONFORMATION JACKPOT DRAWINGS

Don't forget to enter Ranch Conformation or Halter for your chance to win!

NEW for 2024 - Every horse entered in a Ranch Conformation or Halter Class will be entered in the random drawing jackpot!

- Enter and show in a ranch conformation or halter class in the Paint, Pinto, Palomino or All Breed division.
- NO entry form required to be eligible for the jackpot drawing and NO additional entry or jackpot fee required.
- JACKPOT \$10.00 of entry fee - (one time fee per horse per division).
- A random drawing will be held for

- The ranch division
- Each halter sex division (stallion, mares, and geldings) after completion of halter classes for that division.
- A horse may only win one of the conformation or halter drawings.
- The winners of the drawings will win prizes PLUS 100% of the jackpot fees for each division outlined above.

FUN CLASSES:

- Entry fee: \$20.00 per class.
- FUN Classes must be entered on the All Breed Entry Form. Entries may be made at the gate provided horse is already entered in show.
- JACKPOT 50% of entry fees (payout schedule: less than 5 in class – winner takes all; 5 – 10 in class – winner 60%, 2nd 40%; 11 – 15 in class – winner 50%, 2nd 30%, 3rd 20%; 16+ in class – winner 40%, 2nd 30%, 3rd 20%, 4th 10%.
- All Classes are for all ages or exhibitors. Please note Paint, Pinto and Palomino Walk/Trot exhibitors are not eligible to compete in class #88 Ranch Disciplined Rail. All Breed Walk/Trot exhibitors showing in class #88 will not be eligible for any Walk/Trot Show High Point Awards.
- Prizes to highest placing youth (two age divisions – 9 & under and 10-18) in each class.
- Rosettes through sixth place.
- Fun classes do NOT count towards the 2024 All Breed Awards Program or any high point show or year end awards

Class #88 – Ranch Disciplined Rail Pleasure open to All Horses (equines) entered in show. This class is NOT open to Paint, Pinto or Palomino Walk/Trot exhibitors as it will require walk, trot and lope but the horse may be shown by another exhibitor. All Breed Walk/Trot exhibitors showing in this class will not be eligible for any Walk/Trot Show High Point Awards.

Class #114 – All Breed Costume Class open to Horse Show Exhibitors (and family members) and Horses of any color or painted any color. A horse (equine) is NOT required for entry in this class. Costume REQUIRED for exhibitor or horse or both. In hand only class, i.e. horse can be saddled but will not ridden in this class.

Class #248 – Speed Trail open to All Horses (equines) entered in show. Will be run similar to “Gamblers Choice.” Rules to be posted with pattern prior to show.

Class #249 – All Breed Stick Horse Western Pleasure Class Bring your own stick horse or ride one furnished by show management (be creative; don’t forget it’s almost Halloween!). Open to Horse Show Exhibitors (and family members). Open to all levels of competitors. Come prepared for some fun.

NMPHC Board reserves right to clarify fun class rules if needed. Their decisions will be final.

CHAMPIONSHIP CLASSES – AN ALL BREEDS CHALLENGE:

- NO ENTRY FEE but horse and exhibitor MUST qualify for a Championship Class or Award by placing 1st or 2nd under either judge in the corresponding all breed or breed class of the same class (such as color, walk/trot western pleasure, etc.). Horse must be shown by same exhibitor who qualified horse for Championship Class unless exhibitor has qualified more than one horse. Pattern classes (ranch box drive, ranch trail, horsemanship and equitation) will be placed based on top two scores (from both judges) from each corresponding all breed or breed class.
Example - to show in the All Breeds Challenge Championship Color Class, the horse and exhibitor MUST have placed 1st or 2nd under either judge in a Paint Color Class (open, amateur or youth), in a Pinto Color Class (open, amateur or youth) or in a Palomino Color Class (open, amateur or youth).
- Championship classes will be judged by one judge (except for pattern classes where both judge’s scores count).
- Prize to winner of each Championship Class. Rosettes through sixth place.
- Championship Classes and Awards do NOT count towards the 2024 All Breed Awards Program or any show or year end high point awards.
- If you have questions, please ask. Show management reserves right to clarify Championship Class rules if questions arise. Their decision will be final.

- **Class #44 – Ranch Box Drive All Breeds Challenge Championship** will be based on Ranch Box Drive scores (average from both judges in one class) received in classes 39 – 43.2. The top two average scores from each class will be used to determine a challenge winner and the top six. A separate class will not be run. A tie breaker judge will be chosen by show management. If a tie remains, tie will be broken by the horse placing highest over the most horses in a class. If a tie still remains, tie will be broken by flip of coin until winner is declared.
- **Class #64 – Ranch Trail All Breeds Challenge Championship** will be based on Ranch Trail scores (average from both judges in one class) received in classes 45 – 63.6 (Walk/Trot/Lope and Walk/Trot classes included). The top two average scores from each class will be used to determine a challenge winner and the top six. A separate class will not be run. A tie breaker judge will be chosen by show management. If a tie remains, tie will be broken by the horse placing highest over the most horses in a class. If a tie still remains, tie will be broken by flip of coin until winner is declared.
- **Class #197 – All Color Breeds Challenge Championship** To be judged on ideal color representative of each breed. Open to qualifying Paint, Palomino and Pinto horses showing in breed color classes. First and second place horses in each Color Class (open, amateur and youth) under each judge will return to arena to be judged.
- **Class #258 – Walk/Trot Western Pleasure All Breeds Challenge Championship** First and second place horses in each Walk/Trot Western Pleasure class under each judge will return to arena to be judged. **This Championship Challenge Class is limited to exhibitors showing ONLY in Walk/Trot classes at this show (exceptions – In Hand classes such as Halter, Color, Showmanship, etc).** If a horse and rider has competed in all breed Walk/Trot and also shows in a Walk/Trot/Lope (or Canter) class in all breed or a breed approved class, they may NOT compete in the Walk/Trot Championship Classes. The horse may have been shown in Walk/Trot/Lope classes with a different exhibitor.
- **Class #304 – Western Horsemanship All Breeds Challenge Championship** will be based on highest Horsemanship scores (average from both judges in one class) received in walk/trot/lope horsemanship classes. The top two average scores from each class will be used to determine a challenge winner and the top six. A separate class will not be run. A tie breaker judge will be chosen by show management. If a tie still remains, tie will be broken by flip of coin until winner is declared.
- **Class #340 – Walk/Trot Hunt Seat Equitation All Breeds Challenge Championship** will be based on highest Walk/Trot Equitation scores received (average from both judges in one class). A separate class will not be run. Tie breaker judge will be chosen by show management. If a tie still remains, tie will be broken by flip of coin until winner is declared. **This Championship Challenge Award is limited to exhibitors showing ONLY in Walk/Trot classes at this show (exceptions – In Hand classes such as Halter, Color, Showmanship, etc).** If a horse and rider has competed in all breed Walk/Trot and also shows in a Walk/Trot/Lope (or Canter) class in all breed or a breed approved class, they may NOT compete for the Walk/Trot Championship Awards. The horse may have been shown in Walk/Trot/Lope classes with a different exhibitor.

NM CLUB YEAR END AWARDS INFO

FALL COLOR ROUNDUP HORSE SHOW AWARDS

NMPHC, PtHANM and/or NMPEA membership is NOT required to be eligible for show awards.

Ribbons will be given for first through sixth place in each class and for Grand & Reserve halter classes. Ribbons will be available in the show office.

OVER 80 HIGH POINT DIVISION AWARDS OFFERED AT THIS SHOW!

- Separate High Point awards will be given for Saturday Ranch Divisions and the Sunday "Traditional" Horse Show Divisions as listed at end of Show Rules along with the requirements to qualify for each division. Also, a Pinto Pleasure Type High Point and a Yearling High Point will be awarded.
- The NMPHC State Point System will be used to calculate high point show awards, i.e. 6 or more in a class, 1st place – 6 points, 2nd place – 5 points, 3rd place – 4 points, etc. through 6 places; if 5 in class, 1st place – 5 points, 2nd place – 4 points, etc.
- NMPHC, PtHANM and/or NMPEA membership is NOT required to be eligible for show awards.
- Open Awards based on horse and can have multiple exhibitors.
- Youth, Amateur and Rookie awards based on one horse/one exhibitor.
- Walk/Trot Awards are limited to exhibitor and horse (in amateur, rookie and youth walk/trot divisions) and/or horse (in green walk/trot) showing in walk/trot classes only.
- Pinto Pleasure Type award (one high point award) based on greatest number of points in one Pinto division.
- Yearling high point award based on greatest number of points earned in one division. Can be Paint, Pinto, Palomino or All Breed horse.
- Lead Line classes do not count towards any show high point awards.
- Green Horse classes – see high points offered below.
- Cross overs are allowed in the All Breed Divisions between ranch and traditional horse show classes. So, it is possible for one horse (in all breed open divisions) or one horse and rider team (in all other all breed divisions) to win a High Point Ranch Award and a High Point Traditional Horse Show Award.
- High point results may not be available at the conclusion of show on Sunday. Results will be posted as soon as possible on facebook pages and club websites.
- Show High Point Awards will be awarded after the points have been totaled and audited for each division. Conformation, halter and/or color points are required and/or are counted in point totals within a division as designated in charts below. Some divisions do NOT require these classes.

- In the event of a tie for a high point division award, the entry with the most firsts will be declared the winner. If a tie remains, the entry with the highest placing over the greatest number of horses will be used to break the tie. If a tie still remains, a flip of a coin will be used to determine the winner.
